The **CLARITY project** aims to support European Member States in their pursuit for greater trust, transparency and efficiency within government via open government initiatives. CLARITY is a small-scale coordination and support action designed to:

- **mobilise a multidisciplinary network of stakeholders** across the open government ecosystem in order to support and encourage the take-up of responsible eGovernment applications
- conduct an **interactive needs assessment** and gap analysis in order to understand gaps in the market and support the growth of innovative solutions for open government in Europe and
- work with the network to **develop a blueprint for next steps** in facilitating open government initiatives in Europe.

CLARITY adopts a **multi-dimensional approach** to understand the different needs of open government stakeholders operating in society, the public sector, and in industry markets by grounding needs assessment and gap analysis within the **examination of four public sector areas**.
