The CLARITY Sprint Event is a three day hackathon in which three teams of developers and local government officials from Spain, The Netherlands and Sweden work together to build relevant and testable pilot designs for open eGovernment service applications in a so-called 'development sprint'.

The Clarity Sprint event gives participants the opportunity to start solving real government problems where policy makers and designers come together to define and solve problems in an accelerated manner.

The participating government stakeholders will identify different challenges and work with the developer teams toward solutions. These teams will then build testable and workable process designs during the sprint. These designs will result in blueprints for pilots and will also be the first building blocks for new solutions in the domain of open eGovernment. The three teams will then present the results in front of a public audience on the last day of the sprint.

We invite civic programmers to join the development sprint from 7-9 December 2016 and stakeholders within the open eGovernment sector to attend the presentation of results on the 9th December 2016 from 16.00 onwards. In addition to presentations, there will be a chance for discussion and networking between participants.

The public event starts at 16.00 on Friday 9th December and ends at 19.00. It includes presentations of the solutions developed and opportunities for networking with open eGovernment application developers and other stakeholders.
